1 REASON FOR REPORT

Consultation Document published by the Isle of Man Government

2 RECOMMENDATION

4 SUPPORTING RATIONALE

The Consultation Document was published on 21st November, 2022, with a closing date of 6th January, 2023. The Public Sector Payments Bill is a proposed piece of legislation that will replace the Payment of Members Expenses Act 1989. The consultation seeks views on ten key policy proposal areas.

Most of the proposed changes to the Payments of Members Expenses Act 1989 will not impact the local authority Member allowance scheme, which is paid under the Local Government (Members' Attendance Allowances) Order 2013. There is one proposed policy change that could impact Members, and the Council's employees, Proposal 4 on travel allowances.

With this in mind, most questions have been answered with 'no view', however, where relevant, there has been reference made to the need for the Local Government (Members' Attendance Allowances) to be reviewed and updated.
