JUDGING REGULATIONS

All sections of this competition will be judged for their attractive and imaginative display of flowers and plants (not artificial please), designed to improved and brighten up the environs.

Your displays must be clearly visible from the road, to the passing public, and any form of container, tub or window box or hanging basket may be used.

The keynote of the competition is to make our Town more attractive to visitors and to ourselves and, of course, your displays form a major part of the effort for both the Island in Bloom and the National, Britain in Bloom Competition. – So, your efforts will be worthwhile and most appreciated.

LIST OF CATEGORIES

Please note that each category has a prize/s sponsored by or most generously donated by organisations and businesses on the Island and there will be special prize for the overall most imaginative display.

This list will be made available to all entrants in the near future.

Section One – HOTELS AND GUEST HOUSES WITHOUT GARDENS

A Hotel or guest house shall be deemed to be without a garden where any frontage area in principally hard paved, and not more than 8ft in depth. To include troughs, tubs, baskets etc.

Section Two – HOTELS AND GUEST HOUSES WITH GARDENS

Displays that can be viewed easily by the public.

Section Three – PRIVATE HOUSES WITH GARDENS

Gardens of merit offering a quality floral/garden display, which can be viewed by the passing public.

Section Four – BUSINESS PREMISES

This category can include industrial, office or shop premises which have incorporated floral displays.

Section Five – PUB / RESTAURANT / CAFÉ

This award will be given to the best garden or floral display seen by the passing public.
Rear gardens do not qualify.

Section Six – PUBLIC/COMMUNITY GARDEN

This award is for churches, hospital gardens, day centres etc. – special consideration will be given where volunteers carry out the work.

Section Seven – BEST RESIDENTIAL AREA

This award will be given to the street, square or residential area where the residents are responsible for the day-to-day management and maintenance of the displays.

Section Eight – BEST DOUGLAS COUNCIL PROPERTY (House or Flat)

This award will be given to the tenant who has best enhanced the property with floral/garden display that can be viewed easily by the public.

Section Nine - CONSERVATION, WILDLIFE & BIO DIVERSITY

This award will be given to the site or garden that encourages and benefits a range of wildlife with planting that provides food sources, nesting sites etc.

Section Ten – SECRET GARDEN

Gardening gems out of public view.
