Further to the below, it would appear this has now been escalated to the Planning Department and MHK level.

Communication received today suggests that 'the compound was opened at 7am yesterday (bank holiday) and the digger was there moving things around for half an hour from 7.30 which was extremely noisy. I do have a recording of the noise and it is totally unacceptable at this time. They were then back and forth most of the morning at least 12 times and then closed the site around 5pm'.



Living close to this site I object to this planning application as nothing has changed since 2016 when 5 years was requested and rejected due to the impact on the housing around it. Since 2016 this has been a TEMPORARY depot and it finally closed 2022 so 6 years later. It is now being used again and requesting a further 2 years which I think is totally unacceptable and highly doubt if planning is given it will only be 2 years as Willaston estate is far from finished. Planning department granted the last application in 2020 so they could finish the northern part of the estate which is now complete. The noise, dust and heavy vehicles coming up and down from this depot is not acceptable. It is on a bus route with cars parked on both sides so not ideal for turning big diggers in the road when loading/unloading etc. Please see the reasons below on previous applications and do not permit this application. There is already another depot on Barrule Road that can be used, it is not the residents fault that two building sites are running at the same time.

16/01108/B - The applicant has requested a five year approval. Good afternoon

I am emailing with my concerns over the above so called 'Temporary storage depot'.

This is causing the residents of the street much upset, the constant noise from the digger beeping filling metal skips with a metal tray banging to empty the contents of the tray. I have literally been home for one hour and the digger has already been back and forth 6 times. There is also rubble all over the road which is causing damage to the cars when the stones are flicked up by passing vehicles causing dirt and dust along the street. For the neighbours with breathing issues this dust is particularly bad.

They are working to no strict rules at present as nothing has been agreed and have been for at least the past 10 months, they are there from around 7.30 am until at least 5pm. Bank holidays we thought we would get a reprieve and some much needed peace but no they work all day.

I did put in my objections when planning was requested which appear to be being ignored and also voiced my concerns on the last application when it was granted for a further 6 months so they could finish off the top half of the estate which was completed during covid.

This depot is more of a waste dump (3 big skips for rubble, glass and wood) not a storage depot and I think we have put up with this longer than we should have had to probably due to it being a local authority asking for it. The skip wagon was here to remove one of the skips at 7.30 in the morning and this is surely totally unacceptable in a residential area.

Planning department we have had to endure this so called 'TEMPORARY storage depot' since 2016 and I plead with you to shut this depot down and do not allow them permission to be there any longer. In 2016 they requested a 5 year period which was declined due to the impact on the surrounding residents and here we are 2024 and they are still using it. What has changed since 2016 that it doesn't impact the residents......absolutely nothing! This estate is not likely to be finished anytime in the next 10 years so I if they are granted this they will request another 2 years in 2025 as they wont be finished. The houses on this road have been renovated and the houses and cars are filthy due to all the rubble dust from this site.

Can you all just come and take a look at what we are dealing with day after day?

I look forward to your responses.

It was a pleasure speaking with you recently and as requested by you I have put this in to an email.

Application No: 23/01226/B

I understand they are trying to get houses up to a better standard of living, but it is causing tremendous stress to myself and neighbouring houses.

There is no consistency of cleaning roads or spraying site to keep dust levels down. everywhere is covered in dust inside and outside of the home. Windows and doors. Vehicle covered inside and outside, having to wipe all windows and headlights before going anywhere is Soul destroying. I have a reserved park which many times has been covered in muck, that other cars have parked on it because they cannot see the sign on the road.

The noise of the wagons up and down can be 20 times a day and more dumping rubble and glass into big skips and then smashing it down. Is is absolutely unbearable, even with Windows shut you can still hear it. Along with the reverse beeping from site vehicles, this is more like an amenity site than a storage facility the fumes from the diesel engines which have been left to run for 20 minutes constantly lingering around the area you can really smell the fumes.

There is a river that runs from the top of Snaefell Road down to the bottom, and since the site has been used it has disrupted the land, my neighbours garden including mine have been completely flooded.

We have rats at the back which is concerning because poison has been put down and and we have seen many dead ones which are decomposing in the flood water meaning it's tainted with poison and disease, it's a serious health risk. You cannot sit in your own garden during the summer with the noise and constant dust flying in the air.

This is seriously affecting the well-being of myself and my fellow neighbours. we have also been told that the rubble and glass which is emptied on the site every day is classed as industrial waste.

I really hope you can help with what has been a traumatic 10 years dealing with this site in operation. I feel if his continues it will heavily impact further on our wellbeing.
