GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (APPLIES TO ALL CATEGORIES)

- A signed entry form is your guarantee to abide by the rules for the procession entry set out by the carnival organisers.
- · The organisers retain the right to refuse entry to the procession.
- In the interests of safety for both the participants and spectators no alcohol is to be consumed by the participants in the carnival before or during the procession.
- All persons participating in activities and events as part of the Douglas carnival do so entirely at
 their own risk and are responsible for arranging any insurance cover required. Neither the carnival
 committee, its members nor any organiser shall be liable for any accident or fatal or other injury
 suffered by any person or damage or loss caused to and in respect of any property of thing.
- · All entries must be received by Friday 27th June.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (FLOAT)

- Every procession vehicle will provide two steward/marshals wearing high visibility clothing to ensure the safety of persons travelling on the vehicle or trailer. You are asked to comply with carnival health and safety risk assessment policy statement.
- · All vehicles must be in a road worthy condition.
- All motor vehicles and trailers must have at least third party road risk insurance and be covered for Social, Domestic and Pleasure use.
- · All vehicles must be taxed.
- · Floats must not exceed an overall width of 4 metres.
- · Floats must not exceed an overall height of 4 metres.
- To be permitted entry in to the procession each float must be built or equipped as follows:
 - the must be clear marking of the edge of the vehicle;
 - any person on the float must be sitting down or have a safety system whereby if the vehi-cle moves suddenly they cannot fall off;
 - · there must be no throwing of items from the float (this includes sweets);
 - all dressing on the float must be secured so that it cannot fall off during transit.
- Responsibility for the safety of children will remain with the float organiser until such a time when they are collected by a responsible adult at the dispersal point.
- · All drivers and vehicle stewards will be subject to a safety briefing to be held prior to the procession.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (WALKING GROUP OR BAND)

- Responsibility for the safety of children will remain with the group organiser until such a time when they are collected by a responsible adult at the dispersal point.
- A representative from your group will be required to attend a safety briefing prior to the procession.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (OTHER VEHICLES)

- · All vehicles must be in a road worthy condition.
- All motor vehicles and trailers must have at least third party road risk insurance and be covered for Social, Domestic and Pleasure use.
- · All vehicles must be taxed.
- To be permitted entry in to the procession each vehicle must be built or equipped as follows:
 - there must be no throwing of items from the vehicle (this includes sweets);
 - all dressing on the vehicle must be secured so that it cannot fall off during transit.
- · Safety equipment relative to the vehicle must be worn:
 - car drivers and any passengers must wear a seat belt;
 - · motorcyclists and any passengers must wear a helmet;
 - · cyclists must wear a helmet.
- All drivers will be subject to a safety briefing to be held prior to the procession.
